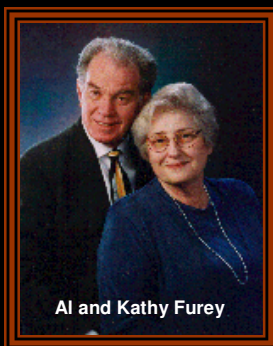
Greetings, I trust the Christmas and New Year season was a great time of blessing for all of you. Kathy and I spent it in Revelstoke, British Columbia, Canada. This is where one of our sons Chris and his family live. It is at the foot of the Canadian Rockies six hours east of Vancouver and four hours west of Calgary. To say it snows is the understatement of the year; it is the snowmobile capital of Canada. People come from all over Canada to snowmobile as well as from many parts of Europe. There were times when the roads in and out were closed to traffic because of snow, ice and the possibility of avalanches. In fact, the day we were supposed to leave in the morning we were not able to get out until 4pm because the Trans Canada highway through Revelstoke was closed, when it opened it was for only 30 minutes and then it closed again, fortunately we made it through. We drove through snow, ice and black ice and fog making the journey very difficult, dangerous and several hours longer than usual. We had a great time with our 3 children and their spouses along with 9 grandchildren. How Chris's wife Alicia put up with everyone was amazing to me.

Kathy and I took the first 3 weeks of January off to rest and recuperate from the previous year of ministry. I had never been so tired. Last year we were in Australia, New-Zealand, USA, Canada, England, Cuba, Peru, Dominican Republic, Indonesia, Bulgaria, El Salvador, Panama and Germany, some of the places more than once. The travel is incredibly tiring particularly when we have to change planes 3 times and stay in airports up to 6 hours to make connections. I can report to you there were great times of ministry as well as a time or two that were rather challenging including when Pastor Dave Olson and I were smuggled into a hospital to

visit a leading Pastor and then smuggled out. We then had to find the correct medicines and get them into Cuba to help the healing process after he had major surgery. The Doctor told us they did not have the medicines available and some of these medicines were incredibly expensive. Our friend is recovering but is not out of the woods yet (see the Cuba report below). Last year literally thousands came to Christ in our meetings and there were many notable healings and miracles some attested to by Doctors. **I BELIEVE THAT REDEMPTION MEANS WE CAN BE SAVED AND HEALED PHYSICALLY & EMOTIONALLY.** God is our healer.

2007 has already started with some great meetings & some challenges.

KATHY - Kathy had a visit to her doctor a few weeks ago about a growth on her nose that turned out to be Cancerous. A biopsy was done and confirmed this and she was scheduled for an operation in Brisbane and a little plastic surgery for the wound. When I asked the Doctor if this was life or death he responded a 1,000 people per year die of this and if it wasn't taken care of we should go to the 8th floor of a particular hospital where we would see people who did not get operated on in time. Parts of their nose, face, Cheeks eaten away. He felt the operation would take care of it all. Kathy had the operation and has since made a visit to the Doctor who said they got all the cancer. The amazing thing is that throughout her recovery period she has not needed to take the pain killers prescribed for her. She puts it down to the fact so many people have been paying for her and so do I. She will not be with me on the next trip as she needs to make some more visits to the Doctor.

Report from Cuba

We greet you with the words from Psalm 46 "The Lord is our refuge and fortress, our help in tribulations".

Last year our family went through a terrible storm when we had to face Alejandro's sickness, and we went out of the storm in victory thanks to God's great mercy and power and His goodness. In November, Alejandro received the last session of chemotherapy of the six he receive , after that he was recovering little by little and was back to his responsibilities, teaching, preaching and doing the rest of the things he has to do as spiritual leader in this nation and in the church and other denominations. For a month now, he has been feeling bad, a terrible pain in his abdomen, he has received huge doses of pain relievers, his veins are all damaged because of the chemotherapy and the intravenous medications.

Last week he had different tests, and they found an ulcer in what is left of his stomach, they took a sample to analyze as a biopsy and it seems that this ulcer is related to an image found in the pancreas. The rest of his organs in the abdomen are normal, the liver etc, are fine, there is no evidence of any metastasis.

Due to the fact that the pain is persistent, doctors decided to place a catheter on his back and that way they give him strong doses of pain relievers so that his general condition can be improved. We are waiting for the medical team to gather and also the results of the biopsy so that they can determine what to do next; it is very probable that he will have to receive chemotherapy

again together with other treatment. We thank God for the doctors who are taking care of him and also because He has provided the medication and the necessary food. In the last few days he has lost some weight, his weight was 190 pounds, his color is fine and also his physical state, his haemoglobin is 11.8 and the kidneys and liver are functioning properly.

We know this is a spiritual warfare, God has given us great promises and the vision of Cuba for Christ has a price to pay. The church which is our family is encouraged and active we have a prayer chain and from 1:00 am to 3:00 am, there are people praying and doing spiritual warfare, we are not alone and we ask you to join us in our prayers so that we can reach the victory together.

So we want to thank you again for your prayer support, and we will keep you informed in the next coming days.

Raise up Oh Lord, the poor comes to you, you are help to the helpless, you know the heart desire of the humble ones, You certainly will listen to their prayers and will comfort their hearts with your help.
